Site Background

The application site comprises brownfield land to the south of Mansfield Road. The site extends to 1.04 ha, and is irregular in shape, having been previously occupied by the Courtaulds Hosiery Factory. The remainder of the former factory site to the south is currently being developed for residential dwellings by Peveril Homes.

The site is located to the north east of Sutton-in-Ashfield District Centre and Outram Street Local Centre. It is bound by Mansfield Road to the north, residential development to the south, Phoenix House to the east (which features a number of service and repair businesses), and Sutton Service & MOT Centre and a number of small factory buildings to the west.

The Proposal

Lidl propose to develop a new store on the site, which will feature an attractive, full-height glazed frontage to Mansfield Road, with the car park extending to the west behind the existing Sutton Service Centre. The new store will extend to 2,573 sq. metres Gross External Area (GEA), including a net retail sales area of 1,424 sq. metres. The new store will feature a dedicated in-store bakery close to the main entrance. The delivery bay will be located along the southern boundary of the site.

Access will be taken from Mansfield Road along the site's northern boundary, with the existing wall to be removed to improve visibility. The car park will provide 136 standard parking spaces, with 7 disabled spaces, and 7 parent and child spaces, which will be positioned close to the customer entrance. The car park will provide 150 spaces in total.

Dedicated pedestrian access will be provided from Eastfield Side to the west of the site, giving direct access to the store entrance through the car park. Pedestrians will also be able to access the site from Mansfield Road. Bicycle parking will be provided along the northern boundary of the site close to the pedestrian access route.

It is proposed that that the store will be open between the hours of:

- 7am to 10pm Monday to Saturday (including Bank Holidays); and
- 10am to 4pm Sunday.

Normally there will be a maximum of two HGV deliveries to the store per day. All store waste will be collected at the same time as deliveries, therefore minimising HGV movements within the site.

Benefits of the Proposed Development

The new Lidl store will provide the following benefits to the local area:

- Improved shopping choice and provision of a new mainstream discount foodstore for Sutton-
- A dedicated in-store bakery;
- A contemporary building design that will complement the surrounding area; and
- Employment opportunities for local residents.
- A brand new store that will provide a clean and fresh shopping experience to meet the needs of


