THE PROJECT

<u>Strawberry Care</u> appointed Rapleys at the outset of the project. Early instruction meant that Rapleys were able to guide them through the sequential approach to searching for, assessing and identifying sites, and then to help them evidence the need for the scheme. This was critical to justifying the site at Little Wratting, which was identified as the most sequentially preferable, and, ultimately, to enabling the case officer to make a robust recommendation for approval of the scheme.

The Cambridge team submitted a detailed planning application in February 2021 and then monitored and managed it proactively to ensure that the case officer was able to recommend approval of the application despite the site's countryside location. The team worked closely with statutory consultees, responding to their comments and addressing any concerns throughout the determination process.

- Front-loading the process conducting detailed pre-application engagement based on presentation and analysis of need data and potential sites

- Working closely with the case office and consultees to **address all issues prior to determination**
- Public and political engagement to raise awareness of the need for the scheme, its benefits, and the scrupulousness of the applicant's approach with respect to the planning process.
